Twin Birch Farms in Skaneateles, New York, is hosting The Classic at Twin Birch August 15-18, 2024, a pleasure show that will welcome both AHR registered Haflingers as well as all breeds. Recognizing that some Haflinger farms also have other horses, classes for both will be offered. AHR Registered Haflingers may go in Haflinger classes as well as



open classes. Melding a variety of breeds into one show is a great way to meet a multitude of owners while showcasing the everlasting and much appreciated versatility of the Haflinger. OOAK Imagery will be on hand to snap memorable photos of your beautiful horses in action throughout the four days!

Among an array of quality judges for dressage, western, English and hunter classes, the show is honored to welcome, Chairman of the Tyrolean Haflinger Breeders Association and President of the World Haflinger Breeding and Sports Federation, Lukas Scheiber, who will be traveling from Austria to judge halter classes alongside long-time Haflinger breeder, Jennifer Rousseau, formerly of Tudor Oaks Farm. Halter classes will be double judged, with each judge selecting their placings independent of the other. One Best of Show will be selected by consensus. Also travelling from Austria with Judge Scheiber will be international Haflinger Judge and Tyrolean Haflinger Breeding Association Committee Member, Romed Posch, and Fohlenhof Managing Director and Stud Manager, Robert Mair. With this exciting group of Haflinger experts, you are invited and encouraged to bring your Haflingers to help showcase what American breeders, owners, and trainers are accomplishing!

Participants have the opportunity to pre-register for several social activities, including the trail ride & drive followed by BBQ dinner and discussion with Judge Scheiber on Thursday, dinner cruise on Skaneateles Lake Friday, and a Haflinger Hoedown Saturday evening! It is important that if you plan to attend any of these events that your reservation be received by July 1st. Only those sending in reservations will be permitted to participate, so please remember to send in your reservations EARLY! The discounted early entry deadline for show entries is also July 1st – please mark your calendars!



IMPORTANT: A negative Coggins within one year (two years if horse resides in New York State), current rabies (within one year) and Flu/ rhino vaccine (within 6 months of show date) are required for all horses, including any horse who is on the grounds to show, trail ride/drive, school, or transit. NYS also requires a veterinarian's Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) within 30 days and that any rider/driver under the age of 18 wear a SEI certified helmet.

For the safety and enjoyment of all, no smoking and no dogs will be permitted on the property.


